Financial support for the coverage of publication costs of Open Access articles from the "Strategic Setting of Human Resources at CZU" project

Dear members of the academia, dear colleagues,

we would like to draw your attention to the possibility of using financial support for publishing articles in the Open Access regime from the OP VVV CZ.02.2.69/0.0/0.0/18\_054/0014642 "Strategic Setting of Human Resources at CZU" (HRA CZU) project.

## Conditions for applying for financial support

- the application for financial support is always submitted by one of the members of the team of authors of the article
- the applicant must be an employee of CZU or a doctoral candidate at CZU
- the submitted article must include an affiliation to CZU
- the application for financial support can be submitted for articles published within the duration of the project, i.e. from 1<sup>st</sup> January 2020 to 30<sup>th</sup> September 2022, and their publication is certain (i.e. they have been admitted successfully or admitted conditionally with minor revisions)
- in the case of support for a previously published article, the applicant must provide proof of publication of the order in the contract register if the order exceeds 50,000 CZK excluding VAT
- the article must be accepted for publication in a journal which is (on the day of submission of application) a part of the Web of Science database and ranks Q1 (if the journal is included in multiple categories, it must be ranking Q1 at least in one of them)

The total minimum of 75 publications will receive support in the period between 1<sup>st</sup> January 2020 and 30<sup>th</sup> September 2022. The maximum financial support for publications is set at 58,000 CZK including VAT per publication. One applicant can apply for support for several publications if they fulfil the given conditions.

The applications for support will be assessed continuously until the exhaustion of resources.

What to do to obtain financial support for publication in Open Access:

2. after the authorization of the application (see below) you will be contacted by a member of the HRA project team, who will guide you through the procedure of the compulsory financial control (compulsory attributes for making an order, invoice requirements and the like, which are relevant for eligibility of costs),

3. after successful publication of the article you are required to send a link to the published article to a member of the project team.

## Conditions for the choice of application receiving support:

The choice of the applications which will receive support will be based on the following criteria, while at the same time it is necessary to fulfil one of the following conditions:

Condition A) the article is accepted for publication in a journal which is (on the day of submission of

application) categorized as D1 (categorized according to AIS),

Condition B) the article fulfils criterion 1.1 and at least one of the criteria 1.2 - 1.4.

.

- 1.1 the article has been accepted for publication in a journal which is (on the day of submission of application) categorized as Q1 (categorized according to AIS),
- 1.2 the applicant is a researcher who received his or her doctoral degree 8 or fewer years before the date of submission of the application for financial support and he or she is the first author of the publication (excluding maternity and parental leave),
- 1.3 the applicant is a woman and is the first author of the publication,
- 1.4 there are foreign co-authors in the team of authors (the article was created within international cooperation)
